Clare Helen Welsh is a debut author from Devon publishing her first children's picture book with Maverick Arts Publishing. *Aerodynamics of Biscuits* will be published 28th September 2015.

Clare began writing children's books in 2013 and was met with immediate success. She won the Margaret Carey Scholarship for picture book writers and she was awarded Silver Medal in the Greenhouse Funny Prize in 2014 for her manuscript *Aerodynamics of Biscuits*. Not long after, Maverick Arts Publishing picked it up for publication and her writing career truly got under way.

She has now since signed with literary agent Alice Williams who works for the prestigious agency David Higham and Associates.

Aerodynamics of Biscuits is about a little boy named Oliver who shouldn't be sneaking to the kitchen at night but he's hungry... When he turns on the light, however, there are pirate mice sneaking away with his biscuits! They want to build a rocket to take them to the moon but they need a little help from Oliver with the aerodynamics...

Clare is a proactive member of SCBWI and is already booking school, library and bookshop events.
